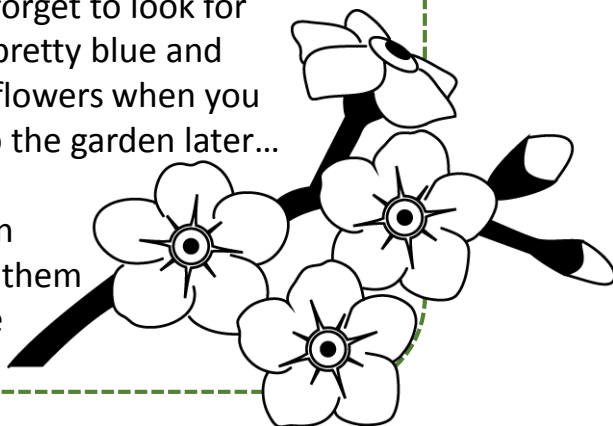

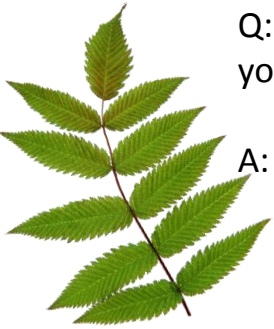
Q: This rabbit was famous for getting chased out of the garden for stealing carrots. Can you find him on his "Race Game"? What's his name?

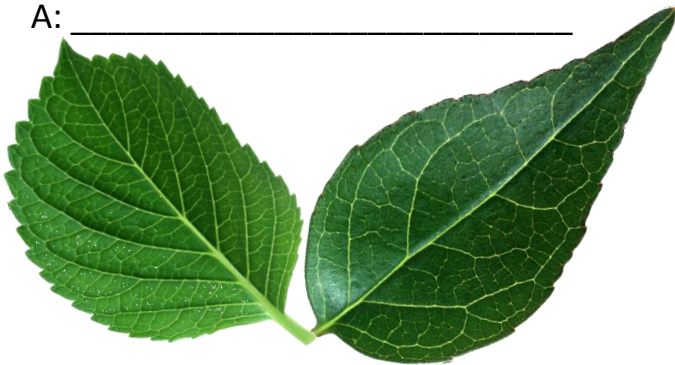

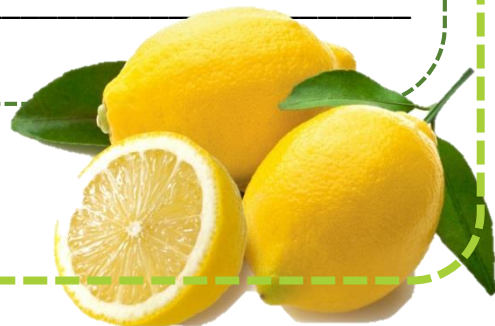
