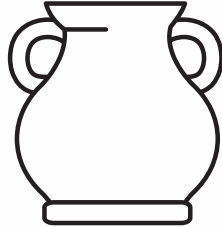

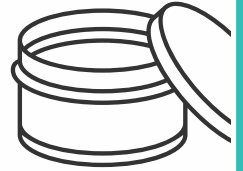
VICTORIAN

Local farms and dairies had subscriptions where pottery flasks were picked up or returned to town to be **refilled**. Can you find our Victorian flask?



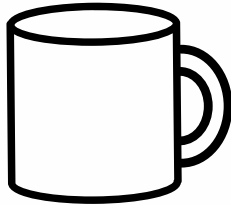
EDWARDIAN

Modern yoghurt pots are made of plastic, which can be **recycled**. Can you find the glass **refillable** yoghurt pot in the 1950s case?

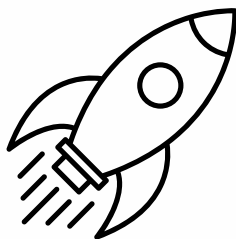


1960s

Count how many plastic yoghurt pots you can see in the 1960s and write the number here. Can you draw one?

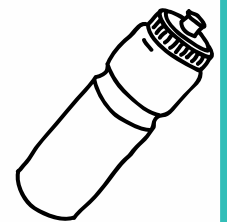
2000s

Can you find the Nestlé Millennium Time Capsule? This encouraged people to **repurpose** the plastic packaging once they finished the sweets.



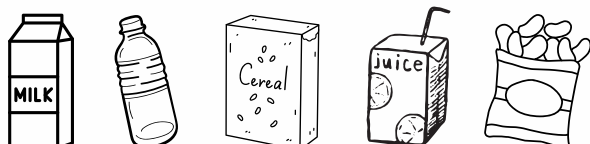
2010s
